Conference Topics will cover:

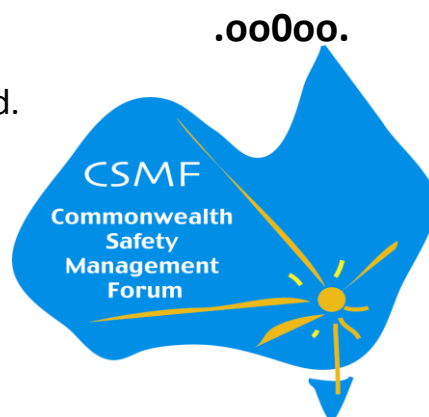
- **Current challenges and emerging issues – WHS & SRC Acts –**

- **Resilience** – Presented by Dennis J Hoiberg of *Lessons Learnt* – Dennis’ practical experience is that workplace absences will be significantly reduced if individuals and workplaces have positive and meaningful resilience strategies.
